

# **NETAJI JAYANTI : DESH PREM DIVAS**

23<sup>rd</sup> January is the Birth Anniversary of our great Leader, Freedom Fighter and Nationalist Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. It is proposed to celebrate this day as Desh Prem Divas to create awareness about his contribution to our freedom and ignite the spirit of nationalism amongst the citizens.

Netaji Subhash Chandra had qualified for Indian Civil Services in 1920 but for his love for country, he resigned Civil Services and joined National Congress. His ideology and principles forced the other nationalists to enforce Purna Swaraj proposal to British Government.

Though elected Congress President twice, he left the Non-Violent Movement due to his belief that Strategy and forceful opposition could only free India from the slavery of British rule. He resigned from congress and formed 'All India Forward Block' and became very popular amongst youth of the country. His escape from House arrest to Europe through Kabul is a remarkable event in the Indian history.

He formed the Indian National Army (INA), popularly called as "Azad Hind Fauz". He became its Commander-in-Chief, declared war against British and addressed people of our country from Rangoon. His famous words were "GIVE ME BLOOD, I WILL GIVE YOU FREEDOM". INA conquered Manipur in Assam. While the advance of INA was stopped due to defeat of Germany and Japan during the Second World War, his actions contributed immensely towards driving out the Britishers and forcing them to give independence to India.

To generate the feeling of love for nation and motivate soldiers from all communities, he gave the famous slogan "JAI HIND" which our college has also adopted as a normal salutation and greeting.

Let us pay homage to the greatest patriot, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, by working towards building a prosperous and Happy Nation of his dream.
